The General Plan is often considered to be the community's blueprint for determining actions relative to preservation, growth and development. This upcoming election on May 18, 2021, residents are encouraged to vote on a diligently prepared updated General Plan, which council adopted on November 2, 2020. Cave Creek Rodeo Days "kicked open the chutes" in 2020 by being the first PRCA sanctioned rodeo event following the initial restrictions related to the pandemic. The Rodeo was broadcast nationally without fans. Cave Creek Rodeo was recognized by the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association as one of the top five best "Medium Rodeos of the Year" and was awarded with the "Outstanding Rodeo Committee Partner Award" by the Women's Professional Rodeo Association. Town of Cave Creek Green Waste Drop-off Days

In an effort to support the community in creating defensible space in their yards for fire prevention, the Town of Cave Creek is hosting drop-off days for residents (only) to discard green waste. The first event will take place on February 20th from 8am-noon at 4300 E Carefree Highway. As part of the Town's Defensible Spaces efforts, we're hosting these drop-off events to help you haul away green cuttings and debris such as weeds, leaves, brush and small branches.

Come prepared with proof of Cave Creek residence (driver's license, utility bill, addressed piece of mail) and be prepared to unload the debris once you arrive. Cave Creek staff will take it from there.

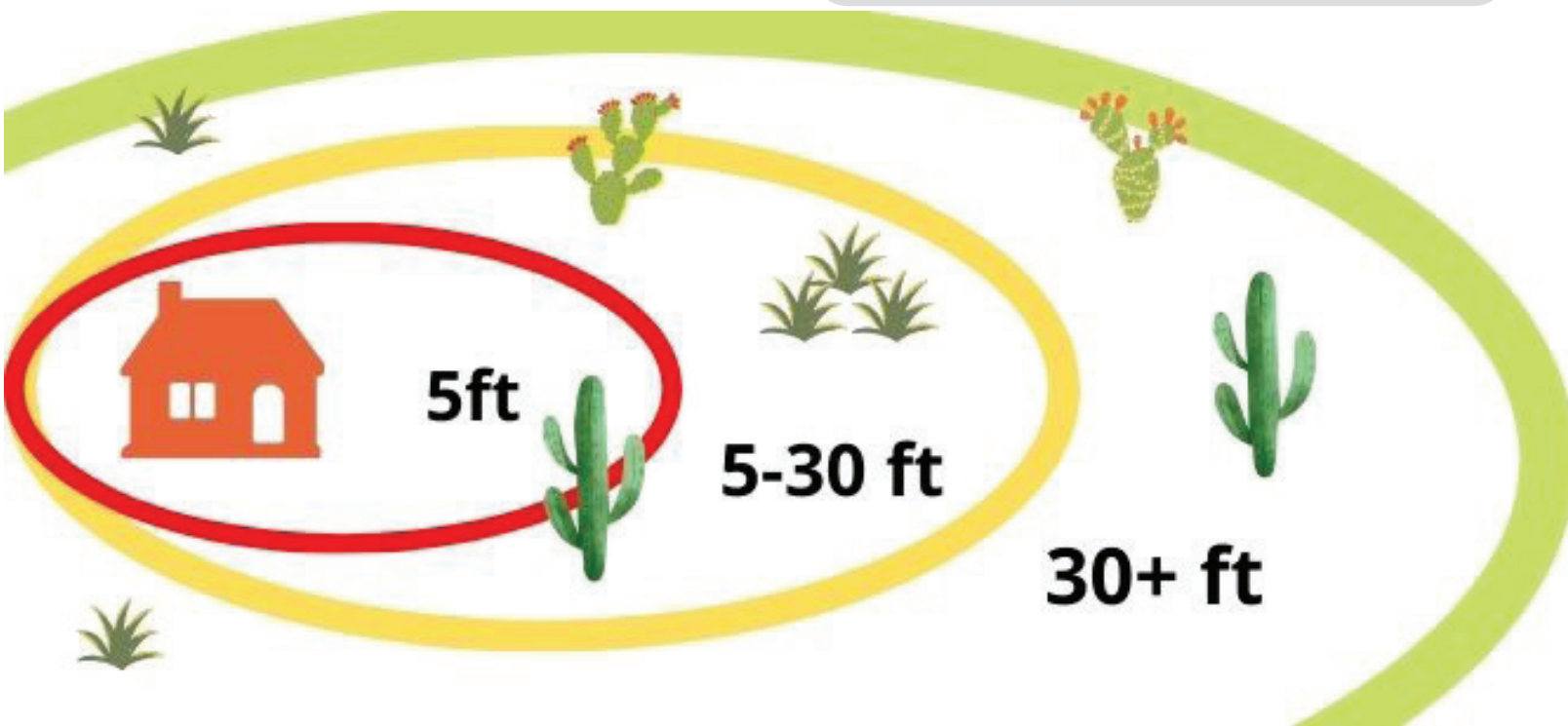

May 18, 2021 Election: Vote on The General Plan

The General Plan serves as a guiding document for implementing the Town Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances, as well as the Capital Improvement Program. The scope of the plan encompasses policy recommendations that address overall community development patterns and long-term land use trends. The General Plan is often considered to be the community's blueprint for determining actions relative to preservation, growth and development.

On November 2, 2020, Cave Creek Town Council passed Resolution No. R2020-27 authorizing a special election for ratifying the 2021 Town of Cave Creek General Plan to be held on May 18, 2021. A publicity pamphlet with information on *Proposition 461; Town of Cave Creek 2021 General Plan* will be mailed to every household with a registered voter in the Town of Cave Creek.
